### Entering a Station

- No additional charge for bikes.
- Enter nearest to collector's booth.
- Escalators may not be used.
- Give preference to the elderly and persons with disabilities.

### In Station

- Biking anywhere in station areas is strictly prohibited.
- Don't interfere with passengers.
- Stand far away from platform edge.

### Riding

On Commuter Rail, await the conductor's instructions before entering or exiting train. On Rapid Transit (Subway) trains, only two (2) bicycles per train set are allowed. Cyclists must board and ride on either end of the last car of the train set and shall not transport bicycles down the aisle between end doors.

Cyclists must wait until all exiting and entering passengers have cleared the doorways before moving bicycles. Aboard the train, cyclists must
